Using the second page cut and paste any of the images to add to your drawings and if you can't cut and paste feel free to copy any of the images to fit into your story.



CREATING A PICTURE BOOK

What you'll need to create your picture book:




Using a blank piece of A4 paper first fold your page in half then in fours and again into eights.

Ask an adult to cut the middle of the page as shown in the diagram.

Using the opening slot fold the paper onto itself. To make the book more secure glue these pieces together.

OR



Using a blank piece of A4 paper first fold your page in half then in fours and again into eights. Fold your page in half lengthways and fold the page on alternating sides to create a zig-zag fold. Using this new fold glue together the two middle rectangles to make the book more secure.
